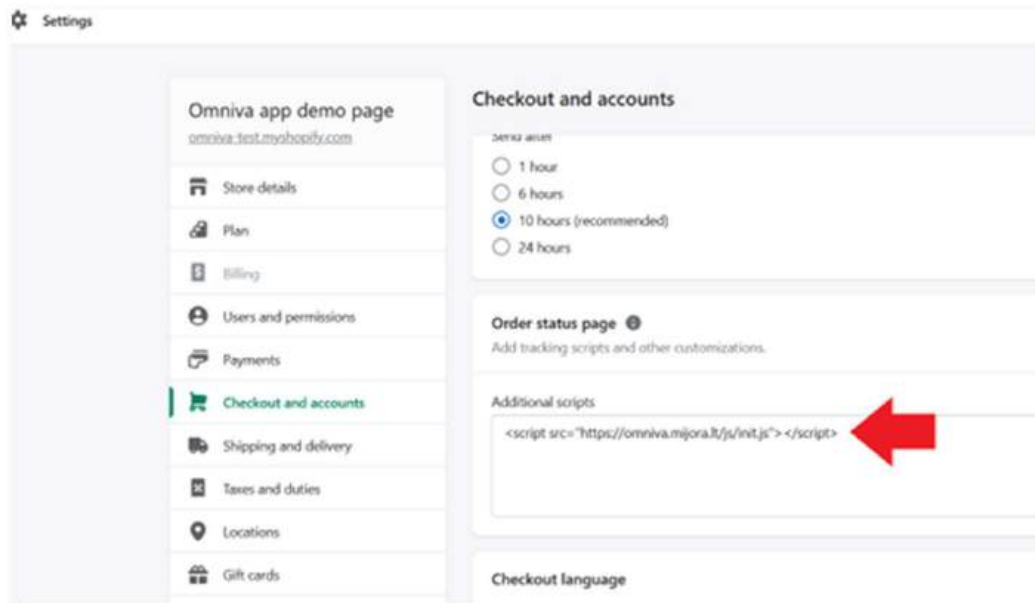
Installation process

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## For existing customers

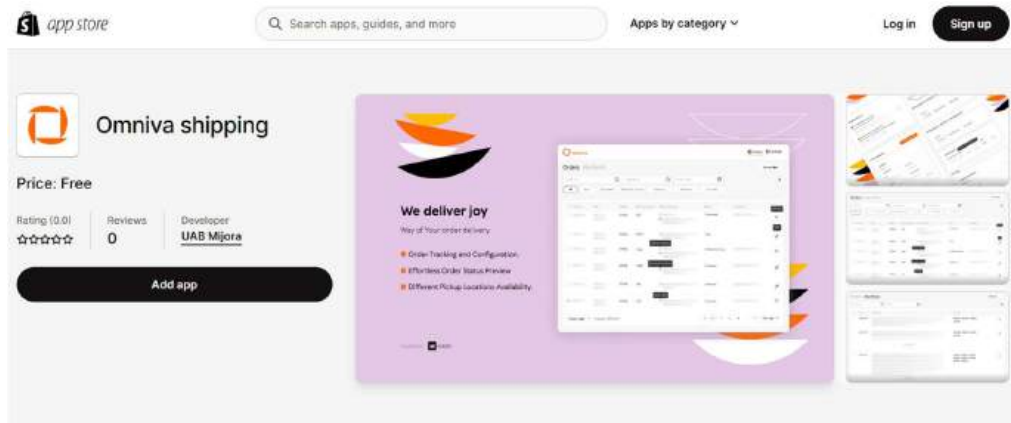
1. You need to remove the following `<script src="https://omniva.mijora.lt/js/init.js"></script>` tag from the Shopify Checkout and Accounts settings:



2. Continue with the steps below, starting from “For new customers” chapter.

## For new customers

1. Log in to your Shopify (<http://shopify.com>) account and open the Shopify App Store (<https://apps.shopify.com/omniva-shipping-1>).
2. Click the Add app button to add the plugin to your store.

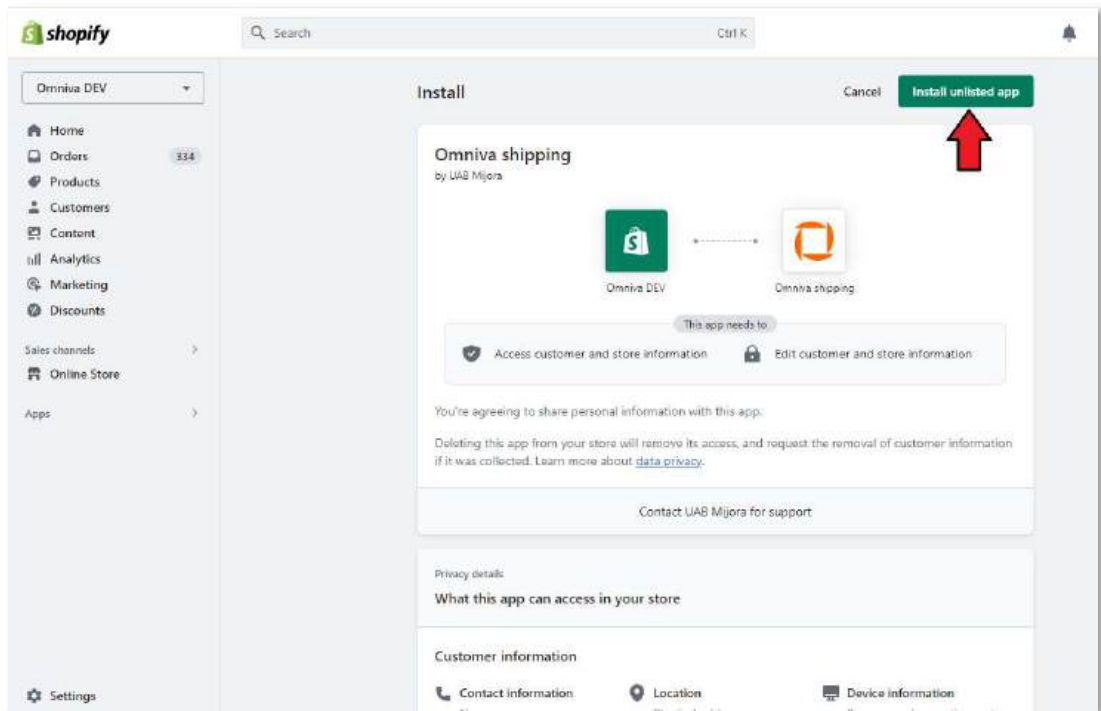

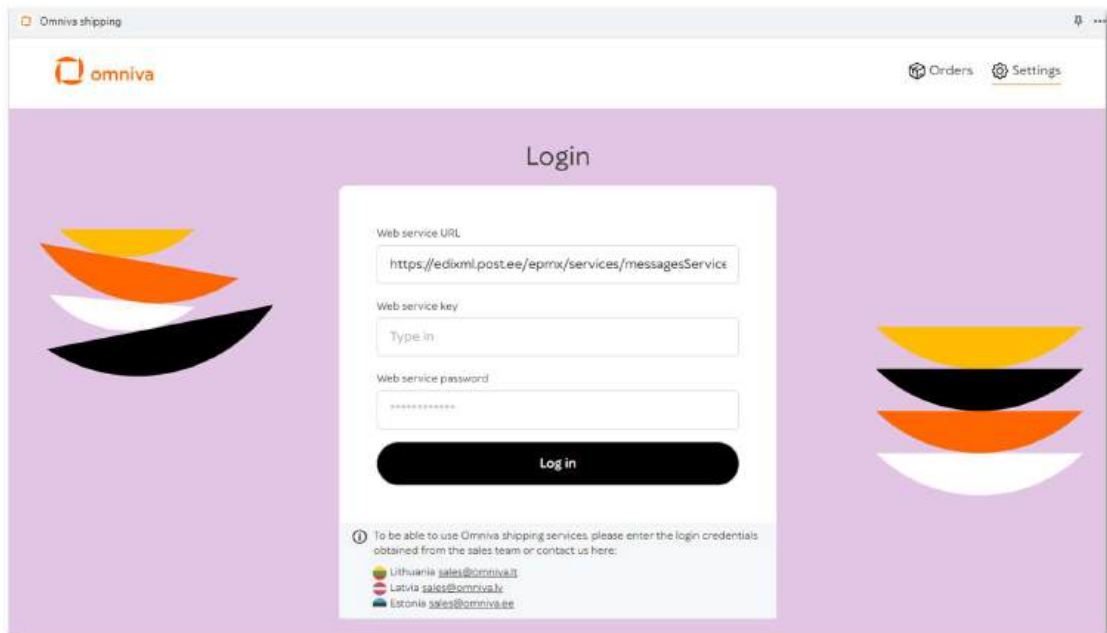

3. On the store installation page, click the Install unlisted app button in the upper right corner.




4. Once the module is successfully installed, you will see the Omniva login dialog box:

## Shopify configuration

Functionality is based on if the store has Shopify service - (Third-party carrier-calculated shipping) delivery calculated by a third-party carrier.


The larger Shopify plans (Advanced, Shopify, or Plus) have this service.

(for Third-party carrier-calculated shipping)

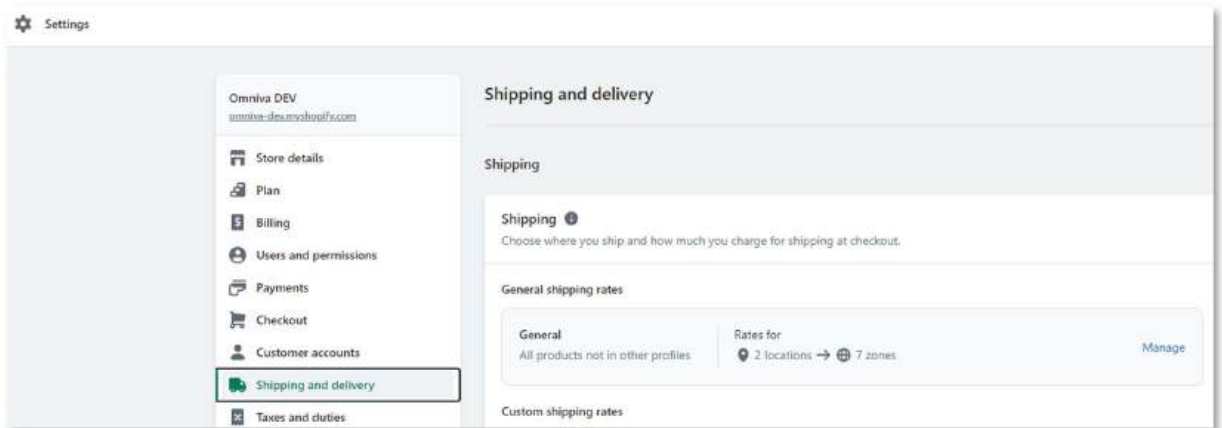
If you have a third-party carrier's estimated delivery service, then:

1. You need to fill in the shipping and delivery management section in the OMNIVA module settings:

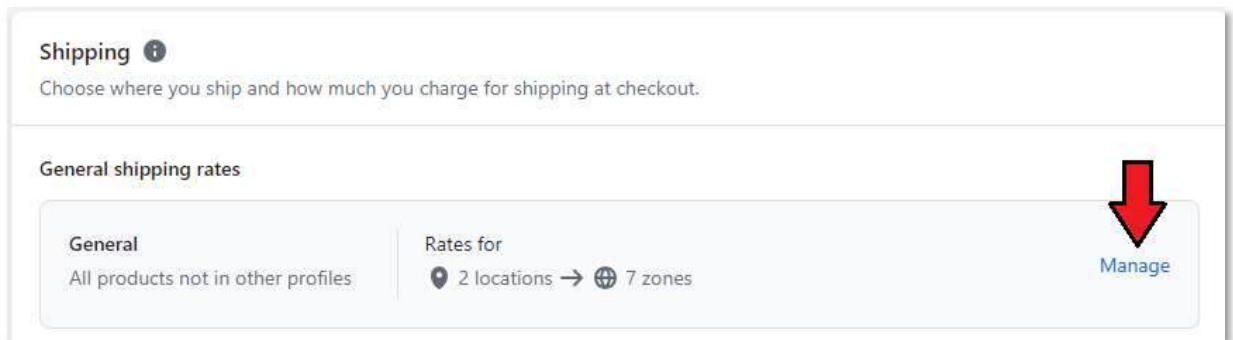

2. After saving the settings changes, go to the Shopify Settings section and click on Shipping and delivery:

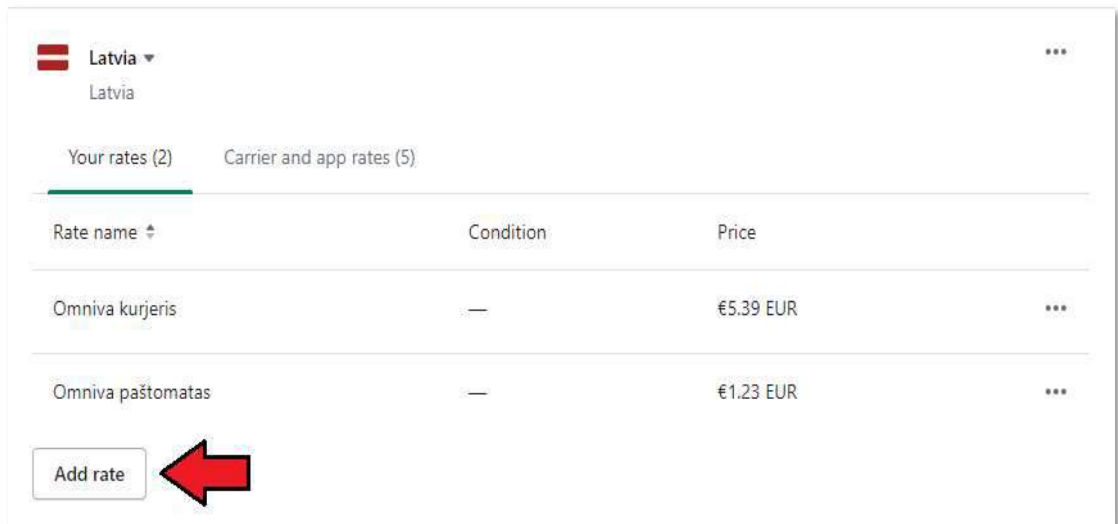


3. In the shipping rates profile, press the Manage button:

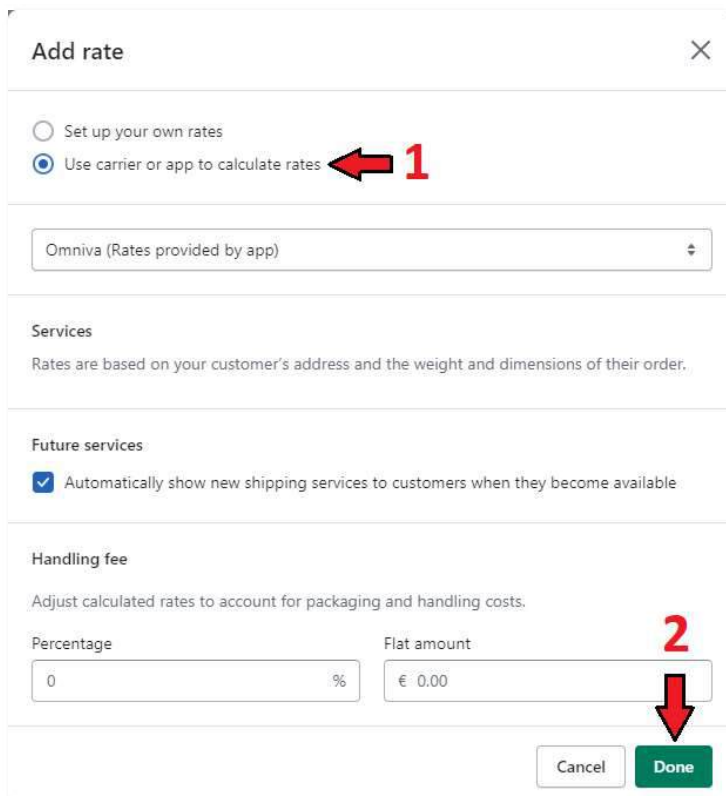




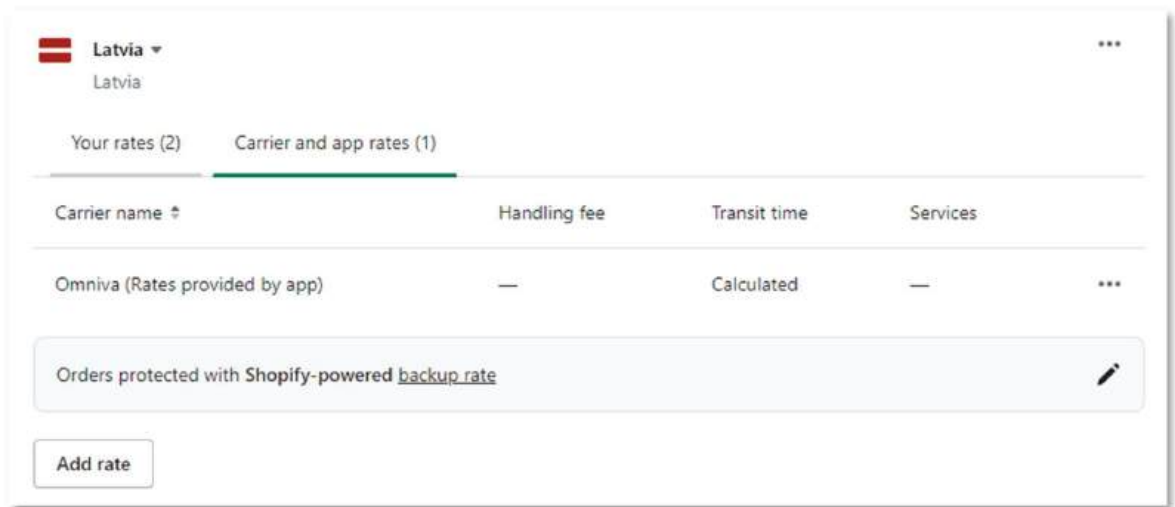

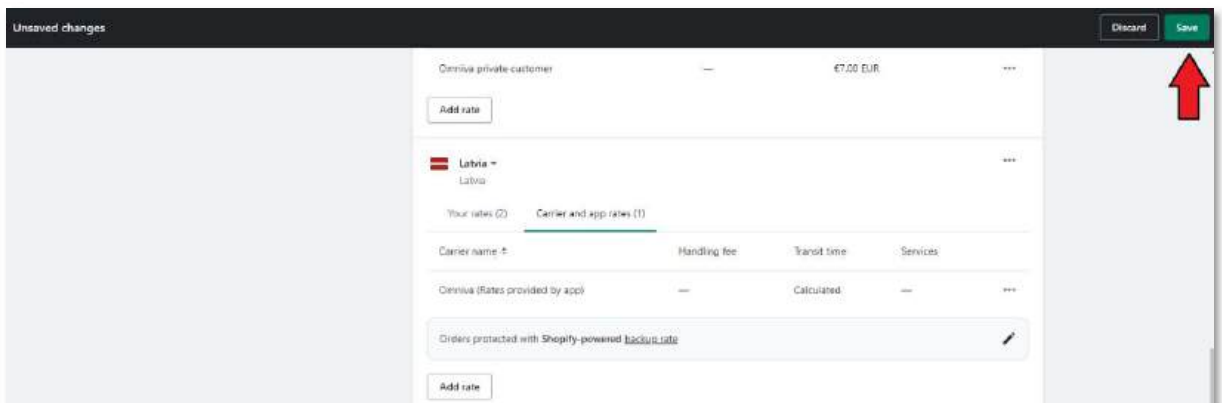
5. After clicking the Add rate button, select the second option in the list (1.) Use operator or app to calculate rates and click Done (2.) button:

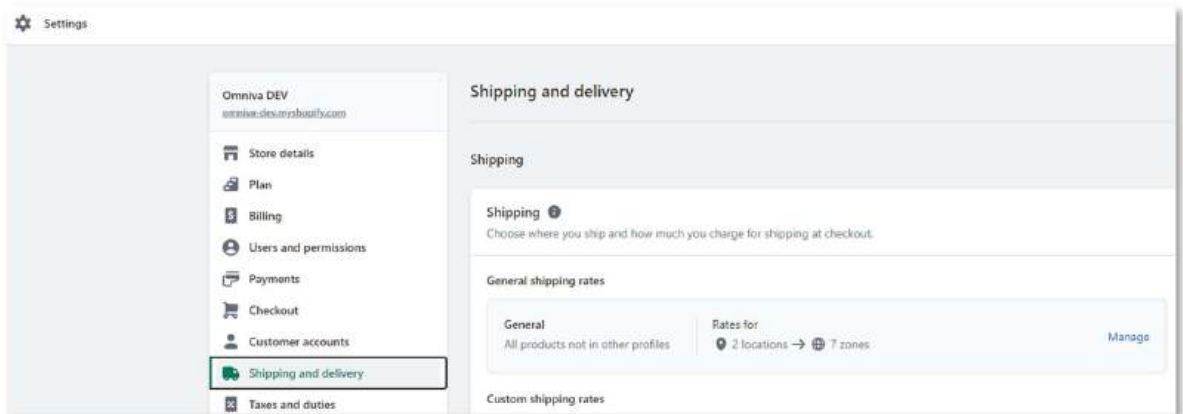

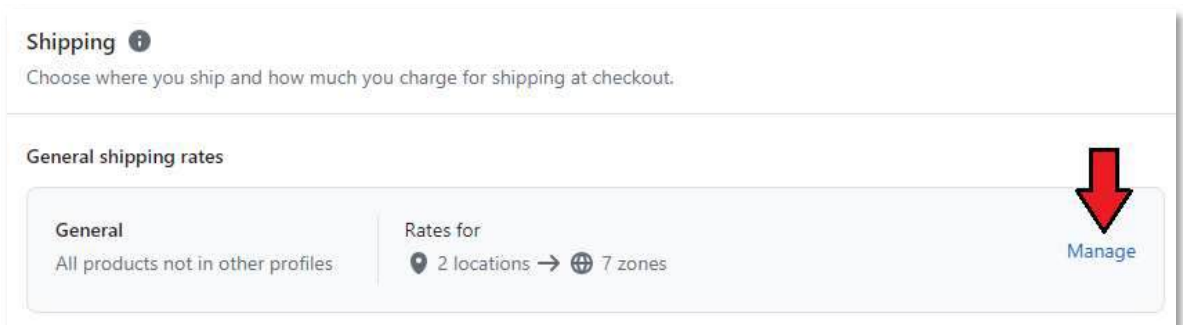

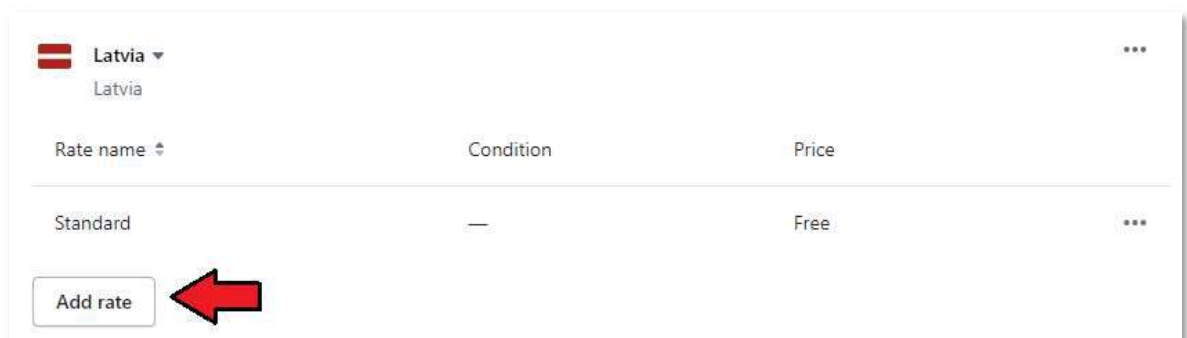
1. Go to Shopify Settings and click Shipping and delivery:



2. Shipping rates In the Shipping rates profile, you need to click the Manage button:



3. After clicking the Manage button, you will see a list of your delivery zones. Each shipping zone will have an Add rate button that you will need to click to add an Omniva shipping method:



4. Select the first option in the list (1.), enter the Rate name (2.) that you want to display to customers during checkout and click (+) Add (3.). Enter the price (4.) and click Done (5.).

10. For possibility to choose parcel machine, for customer at the e-shop, go to Shopify settings -> Checkout -> and in Additional scripts put this:
